4. Read [Genesis 2:16-17](#) and [3:1-7](#). What was at the heart of Satan's temptation? How did Adam and Eve experience good and evil?
5. In his Systematic Theology, Wayne Grudem writes,

“God's wisdom means that God always chooses the best goals and the best means to those goals . . . God's decisions will always bring about the best results (from God's ultimate perspective), and they will bring about those results through the best possible means” (193).
