- 1. What was your main take-away from the sermon?
- 2. Read <u>Ecclesiastes 1:12-15</u>. Why did Solomon say that an intellectual pursuit was "unhappy business"?
- 3. Read <u>Ecclesiastes 2:12-14</u>. What are the advantages of wise living in our days under the sun?
- 4. Read <u>Genesis 2:16-17</u> and <u>3:1-7</u>. What was at the heart of Satan's temptation? How did Adam and Eve experience good and evil?
- 5. In his Systematic Theology, Wayne Grudem writes,

"God's wisdom means that God always chooses the best goals and the best means to those goals . . . God's decisions will always bring about the best results (from God's ultimate perspective), and they will bring about those results through the best possible means" (193).
