




Making disciples shows love!














Make Disciples – Disciple

Training



Disciple-Making Flow

- Prepare with catchup time, accounting time
- Prayer ... opening, reviewing, sharing
- Praise ... testimonies, learnings
- Process ... materials, QnA
 - Share
 - Review
- Practice ... coaching, assigning, praying



Teaching



Start with assurance of salvation and a clear understanding of the G.O.S.P.E.L.

God created us to be with Him.

Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His (Psalm 100:3a).

Our sins separate us from God.

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23).

Sins cannot be removed by good deeds.

All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags (Isaiah 64:6a).



Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose.

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8).

Everyone who trusts in Him alone has eternal life.

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16).

Life with Jesus starts now and lasts forever.

I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand (John 10:28).




7 questions for new believers to develop their relationship with Jesus.

- 4. What's so special about the bible (*why/how to live off God's word*)?
- 5. What is prayer and how do I do it (*P.R.A.Y.*)?
- 6. Why am I supposed to hang with other Christians (fellowship)?
- 7. How do I live out the cause Jesus has called me to make disciples (gospelize)?
