

What is the Kingdom of God?

- It is the realm over which God rules
- It is the dynamic rule of God





How does God establish His Kingdom?



Through Jesus Christ, His Son

- Wherever the King is, the Kingdom of God is enforced (Col.1:15-18)
- He actively rules in us and seeks to establish His throne in the heart of everyone. (Phil. 2:9-11)
- Introducing people to Jesus means we are inviting them to become part of the Kingdom of God, submitting themselves to His authority in their lives.



Through His Word

- In the Old Testament, the law was given so that God's people could live His way. (Deut. 6:1-19)
- As we begin to let our minds be shaped according to God's commandments, we begin to live the Kingdom life. (John 6:63)
- God's word helps us to collectively model His Kingdom in every part of our lives.



Through His People

- Wherever we go we represent God's Kingdom (Rev. 5:10)
- We also can enforce God's will through the authority that God has given us and the power of God that lives within us. (Luke 10:19; Matthew 16:19)
- Our main task is reconciling people back to their true Lord. (2 Cor. 5:16-21)
