

The Book of Ephesians (Week 1) – Study notes

Ephesians 1:1-14

1. Read through the passage several times. What are some of the verses that catch your attention and why?
2. Read Acts 19 about Paul's time of ministry in Ephesus.
 - a. What are some of the things that happened there that were interesting to you?
 - b. What would it look like today for people in our time to publicly repent the way the Ephesians did?
3. In the sermon on Sunday, there were 7 "glorious assurances" that were highlighted from Ephesians 1:1-14.
 - a. How many of these consequences for us can you remember?
 - b. Which ones stood out for you and why?
4. In verses 8-10, we read about the "mystery of His will..." that had to do with uniting all things under Christ's Authority.
 - a. What are some of the things in our time that need to be placed under Christ's Authority that most concern you?
 - b. Are there any things in your own life that need to be put under Christ's Authority that have not been? How will you act on this realization?
5. Spend some time praying about what you have learned from this passage.
