- 2. Read Acts 19 about Paul's time of ministry in Ephesus.
 - a. What are some of the things that happened there that were interesting to you?
 - b. What would it look like today for people in our time to publicly repent the way the Ephesians did?
- 3. In the sermon on Sunday, there were 7 "glorious assurances" that were highlighted from Ephesians 1:1-14.
 - a. How many of these consequences for us can you remember?
 - b. Which ones stood out for you and why?
- 4. In verses 8-10, we read about the "mystery of His will..." that had to do with uniting all things under Christ's Authority.
 - a. What are some of the things in our time that need to be placed under Christ's Authority that most concern you?
 - b. Are there any things in your own life that need to be put under Christ's Authority that have not been? How will you act on this realization?
- 5. Spend some time praying about what you have learned from this passage.
