

START TALKING: What promises have you made? Have you always kept your promises? Who has made or broken a promise to you?

BIG IDEA: Jesus promises to love me.

SUMMARY: Jesus made many promises in the Bible, and one is to love you. Jesus' love never changes. His love is personal, unconditional, and forever.

Bible Verses:

- **Jeremiah 31:3** ... I have loved you with an everlasting love.
- Romans 5:8 EASY But God has shown us how much he loves us. Even when we still did not obey God, Christ died on our behalf.

START THINKING: How do you know Jesus loves you? Read these verses: Jeremiah 31:2 and Romans 5:8. What did Jesus say or do that proves He loves you?

START SHARING: Choose a Bible story showing Jesus' love in action and talk about it.

- Jesus Welcomes Children (Mark 10:13-16)
- The Lost Sheep (Luke 15:3-7)
- Jesus' Death & Resurrection (John 3:16)

START ASKING:

- How did Jesus show His love in this story? How does Jesus still show love to me today?
- How can I share Jesus' love with others?

START PRAYING: Thank you, Jesus, for Your promise to love us. Help us to share your never-ending love with others. You always give us enough to share. AMEN!

START DOING:

- Make a Love Chain and explore ways to share Jesus' love with others. Give kids strips of paper and have them write or draw something that reminds them of love (family, friends, Jesus, etc.). Loop and tape the strips into a chain. Jesus' love is like this chain—it keeps going and never ends! Jesus' love lasts forever.
- Try a demonstration with water showing that Jesus' love never runs out. Take a large jar of water and a small cup. Pour water from the jar into the cup, explaining that Jesus' love fills us up. Then, pour from the cup into another cup (representing sharing His love). Jesus' love never runs out! He gives us enough to share!
