1. My work requires <u>rest</u>.

"By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work. Then God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done." Genesis 2:2-3

2. My work is my witness.

"Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might..." Ecclesiastes 9:10 "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31

3. My work today is preparing me for something tomorrow.

4. Problems are <u>inevitable</u>.

"Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain." 1 Corinthians 15:58

5. My work is always and will always be about treasuring people first.

"So the three mighty warriors broke through the Philistine lines, drew water from the well near the gate of Bethlehem and carried it back to David. But he refused to drink it; instead, he poured it out before the Lord. 'Far be it from me, Lord, to do this!' he said. 'Is it not the blood of men who went at the risk of their lives?' And David would not drink it." 2 Samuel 23:16-18

6. When I work, I never do it alone.
