<u>Seek</u>

Mark 2:16-17 "Why does he eat with tax collectors and sinners?" On hearing this, Jesus said to them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."

Luke 19:10 "The Son of man came to seek and to save the lost."

Matthew 28:19 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit..."

Questions:

- Share how you came to know Jesus with your group.
- What role has the church played in your relationship with the Lord?
- Do you have an unsaved person in your life that you have a relationship with?
 - If so, share some ideas of how you might witness to them in greater ways.
 - If not, take some time this year to pray that God would bring someone into your life that you can witness to.



<u>Grow</u>

Matthew 28:19-20 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you..."

Questions:

- What is one spiritual discipline (examples: reading the Word, prayer, serving, tithing, etc.) that you feel has helped grow your faith the most?
- God created us all differently, and therefore we can often feel closer to Him through different disciplines. In your group, let everyone share how they feel the most connected to God (silence, solitude, nature, reading the Word, prayer, community, etc.).

<u>Send</u>

Matthew 5:14-16 ... light of the world... gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

Questions:

- Have you ever volunteered in the church, been on a mission, or helped a different nonprofit organization before? If so, share how that impacted you and what you learned.
- What are your spiritual gifts? How might you use them to spread the Gospel? (Remember, these gifts are from Holy Spirit. He uses them all!)
