Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me... 2 Corinthians 12:8

WHAT IS A LIMP? WHAT IS A THORN?

1. IT IS SOME DIFFICULTY IN OUR LIFE THAT WE WANT TO GET RID OF.

The sun rose above him as he passed Peniel, and <u>he was limping because of his hip</u>. Genesis 32:31

2. IT IS A DIFFICULTY IN OUR LIFE THAT WE WANT REMOVED THAT <u>ISN'T GOING TO BE</u> <u>TAKEN AWAY.</u>

3. WHY?

PAUL GIVES US TWO REASONS FOR A LIMP, A THORN:

1. TO KEEP US VULNERABLE AND ORDINARY

To keep me <u>from becoming conceited</u> because of these surpassing great revelations, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. 2 Corinthians 12:7

So Jacob called the place Peniel, saying, "It is because <u>I saw God face to face</u>, and yet my *life was spared*." Genesis 32:30

2. TO KEEP US AVAILABLE.

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." 2 Corinthians 12:9

He himself went on ahead and bowed down to the ground seven times as he approached his brother. Genesis 33:3

Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weakness. 2 Corinthians 12:9
