From Sundays message, what did you hear that was most helpful to you?

Read 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4. In these verses we are introduced to an evil figure called the Anti-Christ. What do these verses predict the Anti-Christ will do?

Of course the Anti-Christ will be a real person, but how do we set up alternate, counterfeit Christs in our own life today?

How are the alternate Christs that we set up for ourselves given control or priority in our life?

Now, read 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12. We are told that those who rejected Christ before the rapture will be given over to a strong delusion. What does this mean?

Can you see delusions in our world and culture today that cause people to reject or ignore Christ? Please explain.

Read 2 Thessalonians 2:8-9. What do these verses tell us about the Lord will do to the Anti-Christ?

In the end, Christ will always have the victory, like the victory He will one day have over the Anti-Christ. What victories has Christ given you recently or over the years of your Christian life?

Read 2 Thessalonians 2:15-17. What instructions and encouraging words are the believers given in these verses?

When God says to “comfort your hearts”, what does He mean? How can we comfort our hearts today?

Tell of a time recently when you comforted your heart. How did you do it? What circumstances caused you to have a troubled heart?

What does Paul mean when he said “establish you in every good word and work”?

What action step can you take this week to apply the message and discussion to your life?
