Ice Breaker: If you could travel anywhere in the world on a mission trip, where would you go and why?

Ice Breaker: What are some of the most awe-inspiring sights that you've observed?

What questions or observations do you have from Sundays message?

What does the phrase "God's glory" mean to you personally? How would you explain it to someone who's unfamiliar with the concept?

What are some common misconceptions people might have about God's holiness or glory? How can we address these misconceptions?

Read Psalm 24. The Psalmist poses a question: "Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place?" How would you answer this question based on what you know about God's character and requirements for those who seek Him?

Reflect on verse 4: "The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god." How can we ensure that our hands are clean and our hearts are pure in our daily lives?

How can we practically apply the themes of Psalm 24 in our daily lives, particularly in our relationships, work, and decision-making processes?

Romans 11:36: For from him and through him and for him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen. What does it mean for everything to be from, through, and for God?

In what ways do you see God's glory revealed in the world around us? Can you share any personal experiences or observations?

Have you ever experienced a moment where you felt overwhelmed by God's glory? What happened, and how did it impact you?

How does the concept of God's glory intersect with the idea of humility? Can we pursue both simultaneously?
