- How does faith play into the widow woman's gift? How should faith play into our giving?

If you do faithfully give 10% or more of your income to the Lord's work, what are the values and benefits you've seen by faithfully doing this?

Have you ever intentionally curtailed your normal spending in order to be more generous to the Lord's work? If so, when?

If you have children, what can you do to help them become faithful and generous givers?

Read James 1:17. What do we learn about possessions and finances from this verse?

How should this verse change our thinking in regards to the possessions we own or manage?
