SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

Ice Breaker: When you need to concentrate or study, what helps?

Ice Breaker: Would you prefer to live in a noisy urban environment or a quiet rural one?

Pastors message was from Acts 21 and he spoke on Blocking Out The Noise. What was most helpful to you from the message?

What kinds of "noise" in your life are the most distracting when trying to follow God's will?

How do you typically respond to it?

Read Philippians 4:8. How does this verse help us block out the noise in our life?

Of the things verse 8 encourages us to think on, which one do you need to think on most right now?

Read Acts 21:10-15. In these verses, Agabus and others discouraged Paul from going back to Jerusalem, even though Paul felt led of the Spirit to go. How do other people's opinions (even well-meaning ones) sometimes create noise that distracts us from God's calling?

How do you discern between wise counsel and distractions?

Though the text doesn't explicitly say it, Paul might have experienced self-doubt when facing opposition and noise. How do you deal with self-doubt when pursuing God's plan?

Has there been a time when you felt doubt about God's direction or what He was leading you to do? Please explain.

Paul was resolute in following God's will despite the noise around him. What practices help you stay focused on God's will when making difficult decisions?

Proverbs emphasizes the importance of seeking counsel. How do you determine whose counsel to seek when making decisions? How has seeking counsel impacted your decision-making in the past?
