Ice Breaker: What is the most powerful thing you've ever seen?

What did you find most helpful from Sunday's sermon?

What comes to mind when you think about the power of God?

Can you share a personal experience where you felt the undeniable power of God at work in your life?

Read Psalm 62:11, Isaiah 40:28-31, and Ephesians 3:20-21. What insights do these verses provide about the power of God?

How would you define the power of God? In what ways is it different from human power?

Can God's power be seen in both the extraordinary and the ordinary aspects of life? Share examples.

Read 1 Chronicles 29:11-14. In this passage David makes observations and insights about the power of God.

- What observations does he make in verse 11-12?
- Because of God's power, what two things does David do in verse 13?
- What reflection does David make in verse 14?

How do we balance the concept of God's power with our own responsibility in decision-making and taking action?

Share a time when you had to trust in God's power while actively participating in the situation.

How does prayer connect us to the power of God? Share personal experiences of answered prayers.

In what ways can we deepen our prayer life to tap into God's power more fully?

In what areas of your life do you need to surrender more to God's power and trust in His plan?
