SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

Ice Breaker: How any times have you moved in your life? Name a few of the places.

Ice Breaker: What thing have you owned for the longest period of time?

What was most helpful to you from Sundays message on the unchangeability of God?

What does it mean for God to be unchangeable? How does this concept differ from human experiences of change?

Read Psalm 102. Obviously we talked about this chapter on Sunday, but as you read the chapter, what specific verses or phrases indicate the unchangeability of God? How do these verses contribute to the overall message of the psalm?

How can we share the comforting truth of God's unchangeability with those who may be going through difficult times or struggling with doubt?

How does the unchangeability of God intersect with His love, justice, and mercy?

Make you think: Are there any potential challenges or objections to the idea of God being unchangeable?
