#### LIGHT

#### From the Greek, phōs:

- To shine or make manifest... A heavenly light such as surrounds angels when they appear.
- Same word used for "fire", literally means "firelight."
- Hebrew equivalent, 'ôwr, let there be...

GENESIS 1:3-4 NIV: <sup>3</sup>And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup>God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness.



## PSALM 57:9-11 NIV

I will praise you, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing of you among the peoples. 10 For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. 11 Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let your glory be over all the earth.

## 1 SAMUEL 24:1-8 NIV

<sup>1</sup>After Saul returned from pursuing the Philistines, he was told, "David is in the Desert of En Gedi." <sup>2</sup>So Saul took three thousand chosen men from all Israel and set out to look for David and his men near the Crags of the Wild Goats.

<sup>3</sup>He came to the sheep pens along the way; a cave was there, and Saul went in to relieve himself. David and his men were far back in the cave.

## 1 SAMUEL 24:1-8 NIV

<sup>4</sup>The men said, "This is the day the Lord spoke of when he said to you, 'I will give your enemy into your hands for you to deal with as you wish." Then David crept up unnoticed and cut off a corner of Saul's robe. <sup>5</sup>Afterward, David was conscience-stricken for having cut off a corner of his robe. <sup>6</sup>He said to his men, "The LORD forbid that I should do such a thing to my master, the Lord's anointed, or lift my hand against him; for he is the anointed of the LORD."

#### 1 SAMUEL 24:1-8 NIV

<sup>7</sup>With these words David rebuked his men and did not allow them to attack Saul. And Saul left the cave and went his way.

<sup>8</sup>Then David went out of the cave and called out to Saul, "My lord the king!" When Saul looked behind him, David bowed down and prostrated himself with his face to the ground.
