
## OLORD REMEMBER & TRENGTHEN ME

<sup>23</sup>Now the governors of the Philistines assembled to offer a great sacrifice to Dagon their god, and to celebrate, for they said,


"Our god has handed Samson our enemy over to us."

<sup>24</sup>When the people saw him, they praised their god, for they said,


"Our god has handed our enemy over to us, Even the destroyer of our country, Who has killed many of us."
