



Hermeneutics

Definition: The branch of knowledge that deals with interpretation. The word most often refers to how to interpret the Bible or other sacred texts from religions.

Things to Consider:

- Who is speaking
- What are the surrounding verses
- What is the narrative of the speaker

Apologetics

Definition: The intellectual defense of the truth of the Christian religion or faith.

Things to Consider:

- 1t's not an argument or debate
- No one has ever been "debated" into faith
- Intellectual discussion comes from a place of love, not opposition



- Prioritize our time in God's Word 1.
- Blanket our time in the Word with prayer 2.
- Don't be afraid to use ALL the books of the Bible 3. 4. 5.
 - Search out the context for what you are reading
 - Search the key words

Where can we miss the mark with God's Word?

- 1. There is no such thing as "bad time" in God's Word
- 2. There is misguided time in the Word
- There is distracted time in the Word
- 3. Context is key

Common Mistakes in Context

13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Philippians 4:13 (NKJV)

The Context

- Written by Paul from a prison cell
- Was actually talking about being content with what we have
- God will get us through seasons
- Does Not simply mean we can do whatever we "want"

Common Mistakes in Context

20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, 1 am there among them." Matthew 18:20 (CSB)

The Context

- Words directly from Jesus
- Can be seen as misleading reference God's presence
- Is the continuation of the Biblical model for conflict resolution

How is God's written Word being represented?

- We have and can misrepresent His Word 1.
- There is a difference between not knowing and not caring 2.
- There are people studying God's Word for the wrong reasons 3. 4.
 - We need to be aware of where study comes from
