Acts 2:42c & Heb. 10:19-25

Nowhere in Scripture are we called to live in isolation. To the contrary, we are called *to stir up one another to love and good works* (Hebrews 10:24). 3. This week, how is God inviting you to engage more intentionally in Biblical community? Are there ways that you might encourage or stir others on toward love and good works?
