## **For Your Family:**

**Read together** Deuteronomy 6:12 (NCV) –But be careful! Do not forget the LORD, who brought you out of the land of Egypt where you were slaves.

**Explain** to your family how the Israelites were getting ready to move into the Promised Land, a wonderful place. In fact, it was so wonderful, they might be tempted to forget how wonderful the Lord is! We need to always remember God, and never forget him. One way we remember God is to remember his word.

**Read together** Psalm 119:10–11 (NIV):

*I seek you with all my heart;  
do not let me stray from your commands.  
I have hidden your word in my heart,  
that I might not sin against you.*

Here is a poem to help remember the 10 Commandments.

**Spend some time** this week teaching it to your children.

Love God with all your heart.  
Bowing to idols is not smart.

Don't say God's name in angry ways.  
Rest on the Sabbath; work for 6 days.

Honor your mom and your dad.  
Killing people makes God sad.

Keep your husband or your wife  
all the days of your life.

Don't take things that don't belong to you.  
Don't say anything that isn't true.

And when you go into your neighbor's home  
don't start wishing it was your own.
