### If You Want To Be Great

Mark 10:35–45

## MEMORY VERSE

Mark 10:45—For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. (ESV)

## GROUP QUESTIONS

**Opening:** What types of careers did you aspire to when you were 12? 20? 30?

### Read Mark 10:35–45

1. For context, read Mark 10:32-34. How did the disciples go from hearing Jesus predict his death, to asking Jesus to sit at his right and left?
2. What do you think motivated James and John to make their request? What does their request tell you about how they viewed Jesus’ kingdom?
3. What is the *cup*, the *baptism*, and the *glory* as each applies to Jesus? As each applies to the disciples?
4. Why did the others become indignant at James and John? What do you think they might have said to them? What would you have thought of them if you were there?
5. How does Jesus use this situation as a teaching moment on greatness? How would you summarize Jesus’ teaching on greatness?
6. What are the differences between the cultural model of leadership and Jesus’ model of leadership?
7. How did Jesus live out what he taught about greatness? Think of at least 3 examples. What are some ways you have lived out Jesus’ model of greatness?
8. What does the phrase “ransom for many” mean in this context?
9. What is one way you can serve in the coming week?
