## Made Like Us

*Hebrews 2:9–18*

1. When facing a difficult situation, would you rather read a book about it, or talk with someone who has faced a similar situation? Why?

### **Read Hebrews 2:9–18**

2. Why is Jesus called the founder (NIV: author) of our salvation? Why do we need someone with “flesh and blood” like us to die in our place?
3. Why did Jesus have to be made “like his brothers in every respect”? How was Jesus made “perfect through suffering”? Why does that matter?
4. What did Jesus accomplish by his death as one of us? What is the goal of our salvation? (vs. 11)

### **Read 1 Corinthians 15:54–57 and Romans 8:34–39**

5. How has knowing Jesus affected the way you view death?

### **Read Acts 17:1–4 and 1 Corinthians 1:22–24**

6. How would you answer someone who asked you, “Why did Jesus have to die?”
7. How can reflecting on Jesus’ sufferings encourage you to live a holy life and to share the good news with others?
8. Jesus has three titles in our main text: founder of salvation, brother, high priest. Which of these mean the most to you right now? Why?
9. How much do you trust God to help you survive suffering and overcome temptation? What could you do to grow in your dependence on Jesus’ help?
10. How can your experience of suffering help others undergoing similar situations? Share a time when your experience enabled you to help others.

*For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.*
