- 8. Jesus has three titles in our main text: founder of salvation, brother, high priest.
 Which of these mean the most to you right now? Why?
- 9. How much do you trust God to help you survive suffering and overcome temptation? What could you do to grow in your dependence on Jesus'
- 10. How can your experience of suffering help others undergoing similar situations?
