Acts 20:7–12

Opener: Where is the most embarrassing place you have fallen asleep? Have you ever fallen asleep in church?

Read the Passage: Acts 20:7–12

1. Read Luke 22:19–20; Acts 2:42; 1 Cor 10:16; 1 Cor 11:17–34.
 - a. Why do we take communion?
 - b. How often should we take communion together?
 - c. What do we receive and proclaim when we take communion together?
2. Read Acts 9:36–43; 1 Kings 17:21 and 2 Kings 4:34. How are these resurrections similar and different from the story of Eutychus?
3. Once Eutychus was alive again, what did the group do (19:11–12)?
 - a. In other passages the word translated “comforted” in verse 12 can also be translated “strengthened.” How might their faith have been strengthened after witnessing this miracle?
 - b. How does this story highlight the importance of gathering with other believers regularly?
4. Read 1 Thess 4:13–18; 1 Cor 15:20–22. Just like Eutychus was raised from the dead, we too have the promise of resurrection in Christ. How does this bring you hope in your current situation?
5. Review Pastor Steve’s next steps. Which ones resonate with you and why?
