Ephesians 3:20-21

Now to him
Who is able to do
Far more abundantly
Than all that we ask or think,
According to the power at work within us,
To him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus
Throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

In this passage, Paul describes three aspects of God's power which should motivate us to give glory to God.

1.	God is Able to Do	_ vve Ask
2.	God Is Able to Do What We Are	to Ask
3.	God Is Able to Do More than We Even	

God will rarely do for us what he can do through us. God has all the power needed to carry out his plan. It appears that the only thing lacking is the confidence and willingness of his people—the Church!
