For Your Family:

Read together *Matthew 22:34–40*.

Jesus was asked, “Which command in the law is the most important?”

He answered, *“‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind’ ... (and) ‘Love your neighbor as you love yourself.’”*

He said that all the laws and all the writings of the prophets depend on these two commands.

Tell this story: As the Junior Church Camp began, the leaders went over the rules with the staff and campers. They had three rules:

**Love God
Love People
Have Fun**

They went on to explain how every other rule fit into these three. For example, one way to love God and to love people was to be on time for every class, meal or activity. A way to love people and have fun was to obey the lifeguard at the pool. Another way to love God and love people was for the boys to stay out of the girls’ cabins, and the girls to stay out of the boys’ cabins. They explained that if they all loved God and loved people, then they would all have fun—they would have a great camp.

Explain how everything God tells us to do comes back to loving God and loving people.

Tell how if we all do these two things, life will be better, even more fun!
