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The Power Of Agreement In Intercession

“When We Agree, Heaven Responds” Key Scripture: Matthew 18:19-20

“Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

(Matthew 18:19-20, NKJV)

OBJECTIVES

By the end of this lesson, every intercessor should:

- Understand the biblical power of agreement in prayer.
- Recognize Satan’s strategy to divide praying believers.
- Learn practical ways to maintain unity in intercession.
- Develop a lifestyle of praying in agreement that produces greater breakthroughs.

INTRODUCTION

One of the greatest weapons God has given the Church is **the power of united prayer**.

The enemy fears believers who know how to pray together more than believers who only pray individually. Individual prayer is powerful **BUT** Corporate agreement is explosive. Throughout Scripture, God repeatedly moved whenever His people became united in heart, spirit, purpose, and prayer.

Agreement is not merely saying “Amen.” Agreement is becoming one in:

- Faith
- Purpose
- Expectation
- Heart
- Spirit
- The will of God

Heaven responds to unity. Hell fears it.

WHAT IS BIBLICAL AGREEMENT?

The Greek word used in Matthew 18 for “agree” is **Symphoneo**.

It means:

- **To sound together**
- **To harmonize**
- **To be of one mind**
- **To be in complete unity**

It is where we get the word **“symphony.”**

A symphony is powerful because every instrument plays the same song.

Likewise, intercessors become powerful when they pray the same heart of God together.

WHY IS AGREEMENT SO POWERFUL?

1. Agreement Releases God's Authority

Jesus Himself promised heaven responds to agreement.

Matthew 18:19-20 “Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

Agreement attracts God's presence.

Agreement activates God's promises.

Agreement opens heaven.

2. Agreement Multiplies Spiritual Power

Deuteronomy 32:30 “How could one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, unless their Rock had sold them, and the LORD had surrendered them?”

Notice the multiplication.

One defeats 1,000. Two defeat 10,000.

God multiplies and not just merely adds. Their is multiplied power in agreement!

3. Agreement Releases God's Blessing

Psalms 133:1-3 “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments. It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the LORD commanded the blessing Life forevermore.”

God doesn't merely send blessing.

He **commands** blessing where unity and agreement exists.

4. Agreement Invites the Holy Spirit to Move

Acts 1:14 “These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.”

Notice: They prayed. They agreed. Then Pentecost came.

Acts 2:1-4 “When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind... Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire... And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit...”

The outpouring followed unity and agreement!

HOW SATAN FIGHTS AGREEMENT IN PRAYER

The enemy knows that agreement is dangerous to his kingdom. Therefore, he constantly attacks unity.

1. Offense

Offended people rarely pray together effectively.

Proverbs 18:19 “A brother offended is harder to win than a strong city, and contentions are like the bars of a castle.”

2. Pride

Pride says: “I know better.” “My prayer is more powerful.” “I don’t need anyone.”

Philippians 2:3 “Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.”

3. Gossip and Criticism

You cannot tear down someone with your mouth and expect to build together in prayer.

Ephesians 4:29 “Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.”

4. Unforgiveness

Unforgiveness blocks agreement.

Mark 11:25 “And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.”

5. Independent Spirit

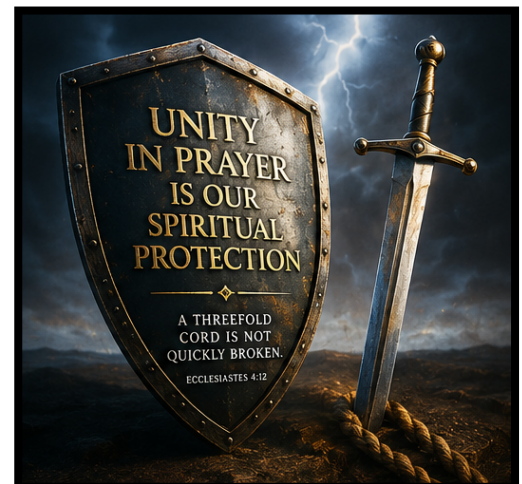
The enemy wants believers isolated. God builds through connection.

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 “Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion... Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.”

WHAT IS THE REWARD OF AGREEMENT IN PRAYER?

Agreement Brings:

Greater answered prayers
Greater discernment
Greater spiritual authority
Greater breakthrough
Greater unity
Greater boldness
Greater endurance
Greater joy
Greater miracles
Greater kingdom impact



Amos 3:3 “Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?”

Agreement determines how far we can walk together spiritually.

PRACTICAL WAYS TO PRACTICE AGREEMENT

1. Pray the Word together.

The Bible becomes the foundation of agreement.

2. Pray the same prayer focus.

Stay united around one target.

3. Remove competition.

Celebrate one another.

4. Keep short accounts.

Forgive quickly. Communicate honestly.

5. Listen before praying.

Seek God’s heart together first.

6. Pray with expectation.

Faith should match your agreement.

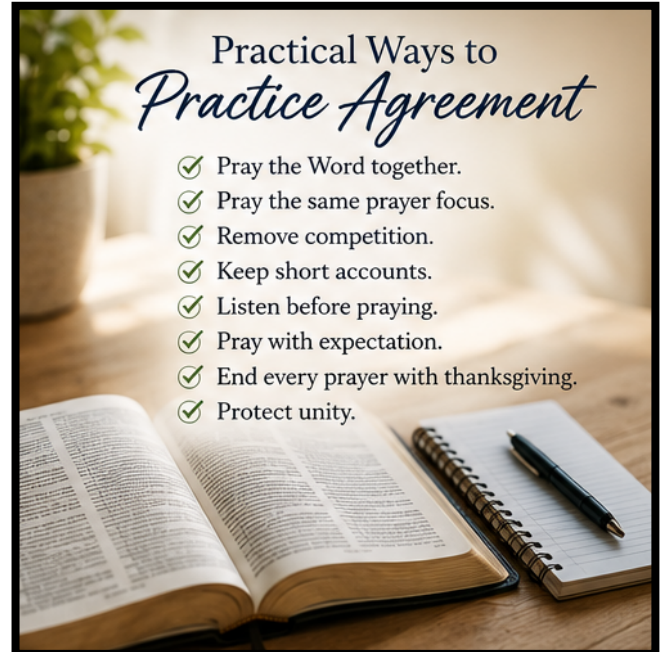
7. End every prayer with thanksgiving.

Faith thanks God before seeing the answer.

Philippians 4:6 “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.”

8. Protect Unity

Refuse gossip. Refuse comparison. Refuse division. Choose honor.

Acts 4:24 “So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God with one accord...”

Result:

The Early Church

The building shook.

They were filled again.

They preached boldly.

Pentecost

120 believers One room, One heart

One accord One outpouring.

Jehoshaphat

2 Chronicles 20

The nation gathered together.

They sought the Lord together.

God fought the battle.

PROPHETIC CHARGE TO UNITE

God is not simply looking for powerful prayers. He is looking for united vessels. The greatest revival may not come because one person prayed louder. It may come because God's people finally agreed together. One believer can shake a city. A united church can transform a nation.

30-DAY AGREEMENT PRAYER CHALLENGE

"The Agreement Challenge: 30 Days of United Prayer"

For the next **30 days**, every intercessor will partner with another member of the team to intentionally practice the biblical principle of agreement in prayer.

Step 1: Choose Your Prayer Partner

Select one prayer partner and commit to encouraging one another throughout the month. Be faithful, communicate regularly, and pray with expectation.

Step 2: Create Your List of 10 Prayer Requests

Together, each of you will write down **10 specific prayer requests**. These can include personal needs, family, health, finances, spiritual growth, ministry, salvation for loved ones, breakthrough, wisdom, or any area where you are believing God to move. Be as specific as possible so you can recognize God's answers.

Step 3: Pray in Agreement Every Day

Spend **10–15 minutes each day** agreeing in prayer over your lists. You can pray:

- Together by phone or video call
- In person
- Separately at the same agreed-upon time if schedules don't allow you to connect

As you pray, stand on God's Word, declare His promises, and thank Him in advance for His faithfulness.

Step 4: Stay Connected

Throughout the week, check in with your prayer partner. Encourage one another, share testimonies, celebrate answered prayers, and strengthen each other's faith. If new needs arise, pray over them together without losing focus on your original list.

Step 5: Record Every Answer

Keep a journal of every answered prayer, every breakthrough, every door God opens, and every testimony big or small. Sometimes God answers immediately, sometimes progressively, and sometimes in unexpected ways. Celebrate them all!

Our expectation is not merely to complete an assignment, it is to witness the faithfulness of God together. As we unite our hearts, align with His Word, and stand in agreement, we believe we will see greater breakthroughs, stronger faith, deeper relationships, and more answered prayers than ever before.

AGREEMENT DECLARATION:

"Father, make us one in heart, one in spirit, one in purpose, and one in faith. Remove every offense, every distraction, and every strategy of the enemy that seeks to divide us. Teach us to pray in true agreement according to Your will. As we stand together in unity, let heaven respond with breakthrough, miracles, salvation, healing, and revival. May our agreement glorify Christ and advance Your Kingdom. In the mighty name of Jesus, Amen."
