- 3. Understand The Necessary of Intercession Ministry


WHAT IS INTERCESSION?

Let us first establish that God is looking for intercessors to stand in the gap, those who will cry out before Him and give Him no rest until His word is manifested and His people are delivered.

- 1. Intercessory prayer is when we approach God on behalf of a person or a group of people, to present their needs to Him.
- 2. Intercession payer is when we seek God in prayer asking Him to intervene or to move and work on behalf of someone else.

- 3. Intercessory prayer is when we cry out to God for someone else.
- 4. Intercession is the act of making a prayer, petition, request or entreaty/plea for another.

While there are different kinds of prayer, the prayer of intercession is unique in that it is always offered on the behalf of another.

We are exhorted by the scriptures to pray with all kinds of prayer and while this study is on the prayer of intercession; it is also important for us to have a basic understanding on the different kinds of prayers.

Ephesians 6:18 & 1 Timothy 2:1-3 We must use all the different kinds of prayer and be aware of the occasions to pray.

- 1. <u>Prayer Of Supplication/Petitions:</u> Philippians 4:6-7 This is when we pray to God about our personal needs. It always has a definite personal request.
- 2. **Prayer Of Faith:** James 5:14-15 This is a prayer made for the healing of another in faith and by the anointing.
- 3. <u>Prayer Of Thanksgiving:</u> Philippians 4:6 & 1 Timothy 2:1 All prayer must be done in thanksgiving. But the prayer of thanksgiving is when we take time to specifically offer thanks to God simply for who He is and what He has done.
- 4. <u>Prayers Of Confession And Repentance</u>: 2 Chronicles 7:14 This is a set aside time of prayer where we are committing our hearts and lives to God in obedience; confessing and repenting of our sins.
- 5. <u>The Prayers Of Intercession:</u> 1 Timothy 2:1 These are prayers offered to God for the benefit of another.

NOTE: Not all prayers are intercession and not all intercession are prayers. In <u>Genesis 18:16-33</u>, Abraham petitioned God to withhold impending judgement. But in <u>Genesis 14:1 & 11-16</u>, Abraham stood in the gap for Lot by aiding his deliverance in a literal way. Some intercessions are done in prayer and others are done when we intervene for the sake of another in natural and practical way.

INTERCESSION IS A MINISTRY: An intercessor is a prayer minister because he/she serves and minister to the needs of others in prayer. The Greek word for minister in its simplest form means to serve. **Acts 6:4.** The type of minister you are is defined by what and where you serve or minister to the needs of others. A dance minister, praise and worship minister, a teacher or a prayer minister are examples of the different kinds of areas we can serve and minister in the body of Christ.

CLASSIC EXAMPLES OF BIBLICAL INTERCESSORS:

- 1. Samuel cried unto God for the people of Israel **<u>1 Samuel 7:5-9</u>**
- 2. Jesus interceded for Peter (prophetic intercession) Luke 22:31-32
- 3. Epaphras struggled, wrestled, labored and fervently prayed, for the saints to be matured and fully assured of God's will. <u>Colossians 4:12</u>
- 4. The church prayed for Peter and God delivered him from Herod's evil plot of death. Acts 12:5
- 5. Esther fasted and prayed for her people. She did not rest until they safe. Her intercession overrides a verdict of death. Esther 4:16 & Esther chapters 7 & 8.
- 6. Job prayed for his friends Job 42:10. Job also made intercession for his children Job 1:4-5

IDENTIFYING THE DIFFERENT KINDS OF INTERCESSORS:

The kind or type of intercessor you are is usually based on the area that you are assigned to. However, we should focus more on the assignment rather than being identify with a specific kind or type of intercessor. Yes, we should be acquainted with our flow/style and vine of intercession but we must not allow ourselves to be limited in how God can use us in the vast arena of intercession. Remember God chooses intercessors based on availability and not ability. What makes an intercessor truly effective is when they are available and they have an understanding of their assignment. The Apostles understood their assignment so they devoted themselves to a life of prayer and the word.

- Prophetic Intercessors: These intercessors are usually moved by the Holy Spirit in a prophetic way to stand in the gap for others, be it in a dream, vision or a prophetic word. <u>Revelation 19:10</u>. Jeremiah, Daniel, Elijah, Jesus and Paul are some examples of prophetic intercessors. <u>Jeremiah 1:9-10</u>, Daniel 9:2-4, 1 Kings 18:41-46, John 17:20-23, 1 Timothy 1:18.
- 2. <u>Burden Bearers</u>: These intercessors are those who travail in prayer with a weight from the Lord, they pray through until the burden or the weight is lifted. Paul travailed for Christ to be formed in the people and we must travail until we see what we are praying for. <u>Galatians 4:19 & Isaiah 53:11.</u>


- 3. <u>Prayer Warriors</u>: These are the intercessors who wage war in the spirit realm contending with demonic powers through prayer so that others can be set free. Through this kind of intercession we saw how Angels were sent to confront the prince spirit of Persia when Daniel prayed. By spiritual warfare, Paul fought with the beast at Ephesus, the church prayed for Peter and Samuel oppose the Philistines. <u>1 Corinthians 15:32, Daniel 10:13, Acts 12:5, 1 Samuel 7:13.</u>
- 4. <u>Governmental Intercessors/Apostolic Intercessors:</u> These intercessors are those that God has given influence in governmental and political arenas. They are moved by God to pray concerning laws, political alters and governmental high places. Daniel, Esther, Joseph, Moses, Elijah, Samuel and Esther are examples of governmental intercessors.

THE NECESSITY AND IMPORTANCE OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERCESSION:

Let us first remember that certain things will not happen until we pray. In <u>Revelation 8:1-7</u>, heaven was silent until the saints began to pray. Even the will of God in the earth cannot be released without the prayers of the saints, Matthew 6:12. This ministry of intercession is so powerful that through it God is able to deliver even people who are guilty and locked up in spiritual captivity, and demonic cycles, <u>Job 22:30 & Acts 12: 1-5</u>.

Samuel prayed and God delivered the people from the Philistines. As long as he was their intercessor they had rest from philistine oppression. <u>**1 Samuel 7:5-9, 13.</u>** Daniel interceded</u>

through prayer and fasting and God delivered His people from generational captivity and demonic oppression.

God can remove impending judgement through the ministry of intercession, **Numbers 14:1-25**.

When we make it a priority to intercede for others God will make our personal deliverance His priority. Job prayed for his friends and God delivered Job and restored him double, **Job 42:10**.



Acts 12:1-19 KJV

[1] Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church. [2] And he killed James the brother of John with the sword. [3] And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.) [4] And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people. [5] Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. [6] And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison. [7] And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands. [8] And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me. [9] And he went out, and followed him; and wist not that it was true which was done by the angel; but thought he saw a vision. [10] When they were past the first and the second ward, they came unto the iron gate that leadeth unto the city; which opened to them of his own accord: and they went out, and passed on through one street; and forthwith the angel departed from him. [11] And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and from all the expectation of the people of the Jews. [14] And when she knew Peter's voice, she opened not the gate for gladness, but ran in, and told how Peter stood before the gate. [15] And they said unto her, Thou art mad. But she constantly affirmed that it was even so. Then said they, It is his angel. [16] But Peter continued knocking: and when they had opened the door, and saw him, they were astonished. [17] But he, beckoning unto them with the hand to hold their peace, declared unto them how the Lord had brought him out of the prison. [3] And wherefore hath the Lord brought us unto this land, to fall by the sword, that our wives and our children should be a prey? were it not better for us to return into Egypt? [4] And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt. [5] Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the congregation of the children of Israel. [9] Only rebel not ye against the Lord, neither fear ye the people of the land; for they are bread for us: their defence is departed from them, and the Lord is with us: fear them not. [10] But all the congregation bade stone them with stones. And the glory of the Lord appeared in the tabernacle of the congregation before all the children of Israel. [11] And the Lord said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have

shewed among them? [12] I will smite them with the pestilence, and disinherit them, and will make of thee a greater nation and mightier than they. [13] And Moses said unto the Lord, Then the Egyptians shall hear it, (for thou broughtest up this people in thy might from among them;) [14] And they will tell it to the inhabitants of this land: for they have heard that thou Lord art among this people, that thou Lord art seen face to face, and that thy cloud standeth over them, and that thou goest before them, by day time in a pillar of a cloud, and in a pillar of fire by night. [15] Now if thou shalt kill all this people as one man, then the nations which have heard the fame of thee will speak, saying, [16] Because the Lord was not able to bring this people into the land which he sware unto them, therefore he hath slain them in the wilderness. [17] And now, I beseech thee, let the power of my Lord be great, according as thou hast spoken, saying, [18] The Lord is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. [19] Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. [20] And the Lord said, I have pardoned according to thy word: [21] But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord. [22] Because all those men which have seen my glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice; [23] Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it: [24] But my servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it. [25] (Now the Amalekites and the Canaanites dwelt in the valley.) To morrow turn you, and get you into the wilderness by the way of the Red sea.





[21] Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: [22] But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
