Identity for Entry Knowing Who You Are (Romans 8:11-17)

"But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together."

Sonship; The Prerequisite for Access (Romans 8:15)

- **Adoption-** Yhiothesia; The process of establishing heirship. Placing a son in lineage of the patriarch.
- Abba- Abba; Source, sustainer, protector, provider; Daddy God.
- Heirs- Klēronomos; One who receives his allotted possession by right of sonship.
- **Joint-Heirs-** Sygklēronomos; One who obtains something assigned to himself with others, a joint participant in inheritance

Once we grasp the revelation that we are sons of God and joint heirs with Christ we will understand It's not God's reluctancy to give, it's our hesitancy to ask (Luke 11:5-13)

• The Danger of Identity: The John Doe Principle (Acts 19:13-16)

When we fail to realize who we are we operate as vagabonds and we can not be located in the spirit.

The enemy will toe tag us as unidentifiable until our identity is reclaimed. When we are unaware of our identity we are ignorant of his devices (2 Corinthians 2:11)

We miss the revelation of Christ if our identity is misplaced. (Matthew 16:13-20)

• Identity Crisis Leads to Witchcraft (1 Samuel 28:7-15)

When our identity is in question we pull on the anointing of others. The enemy will have a field day with this intercesor because they will never cover their watch, they will watch others

Why speak to the dead when God lives!

Understand your are the seed of the promise, we become GMO when are roots are born from propagation

• The Assignment of identity; Types of intercessors

- 1. Prophetic Intercessors: These intercessors are usually moved by the Holy Spirit in a prophetic way to stand in the gap for others, be it in a dream, vision or a prophetic word. Revelation 19:10. Jeremiah, Daniel, Elijah, Jesus and Paul are some examples of prophetic intercessors. Jeremiah 1:9-10, Daniel 9:2-4, 1 Kings 18:41-46, John 17:20-23, 1 Timothy 1:18.
- 2. Burden Bearers: These intercessors are those who travail in prayer with a weight from the Lord, they pray through until the burden or the weight is lifted. Paul travailed for Christ to be formed in the people and we must travail until we see what we are praying for. Galatians 4:19 & Isaiah 53:11.
- 3. Prayer Warriors: These are the intercessors who wage war in the spirit realm contending with demonic powers through prayer so that others can be set free. Through this kind of intercession we saw how Angels were sent to confront the prince spirit of Persia when Daniel prayed. By spiritual warfare, Paul fought with the beast at Ephesus, the church prayed for Peter and Samuel oppose the Philistines. 1 Corinthians 15:32, Daniel 10:13, Acts 12:5, 1 Samuel 7:13.
- 4. Governmental Intercessors/Apostolic Intercessors: These intercessors are those that God has given influence in governmental and political arenas. They are moved by God to pray concerning laws, political alters and governmental high places. Daniel, Esther, Joseph, Moses, Elijah, Samuel and Esther are examples of governmental intercessors.

Herod's Violence to the Church

¹ Now about that time Herod the king stretched out his hand to harass some from the church. ² Then he killed James the brother of John with the sword. ³ And because he saw that it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to seize Peter also. Now it was during the Days of Unleavened Bread. ⁴ So when he had arrested him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four [a]squads of soldiers to keep him, intending to bring him before the people after Passover.

Peter Freed from Prison

⁵ Peter was therefore kept in prison, but [b]constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church. ⁶ And when Herod was about to bring him out, that night Peter was sleeping, bound with two chains between two soldiers; and the guards before the door were [c]keeping the prison. ⁷ Now behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shone in the prison; and he struck Peter on the side and raised him up, saying, "Arise quickly!" And his chains fell off his hands. ⁸ Then the angel said to him, "Gird yourself and tie on your sandals"; and so he did. And he said to him, "Put on your garment and follow me." ⁹ So he went out and followed him, and did not

know that what was done by the angel was real, but thought he was seeing a vision. ¹⁰ When they were past the first and the second guard posts, they came to the iron gate that leads to the city, which opened to them of its own accord; and they went out and went down one street, and immediately the angel departed from him.

- ¹¹ And when Peter had come to himself, he said, "Now I know for certain that the Lord has sent His angel, and has delivered me from the hand of Herod and from all the expectation of the Jewish people."
- ¹² So, when he had considered this, he came to the house of Mary, the mother of John whose surname was Mark, where many were gathered together praying. ¹³ And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a girl named Rhoda came to answer. ¹⁴ When she recognized Peter's voice, because of her gladness she did not open the gate, but ran in and announced that Peter stood before the gate. ¹⁵ But they said to her, "You are beside yourself!" Yet she kept insisting that it was so. So they said, "It is his angel."
- ¹⁶ Now Peter continued knocking; and when they opened the door and saw him, they were astonished.

The Whole Armor of God
