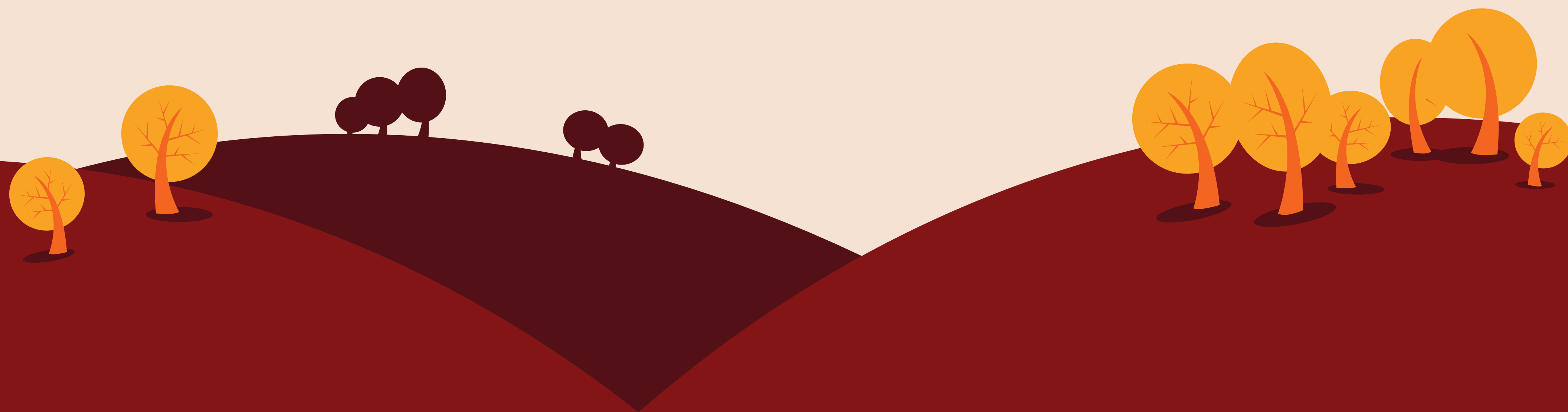


remembering that we are dust.*

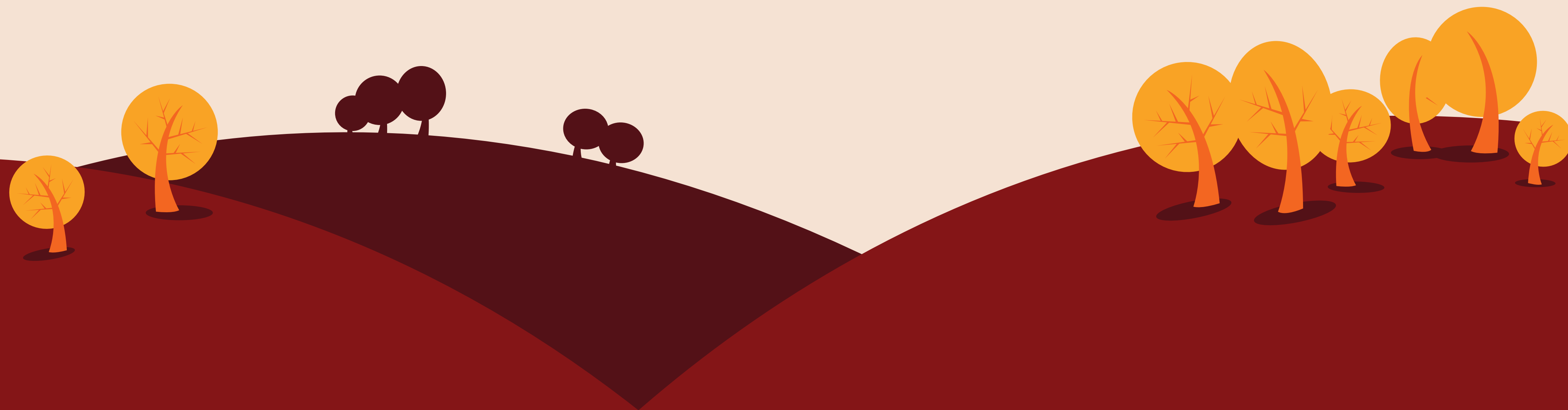
