PART 6 Blessed Are the Pure in Heart

Matthew 5:8



¹When he saw the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. ²Then he began to teach them, saying:

- ³ "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs.
- ⁴ Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- ⁵ Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.



MATTHEW 5:1–8

- ⁶ Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- ⁷ Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- ⁸ Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.



MATTHEW 5:1–8

1. The heart is the control center of our lives.

Keep your **heart** with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life. (Prov. 4:23 NKJV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart... (*Proverbs 3:5*).

You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your **heart**. (Jeremiah 29:13).

2. The pure heart is an undivided heart.

a. Problem of the heart

For from the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, sexual immoralities, thefts, false testimonies, slander. ²⁰ These are the things that defile a person. (Matthew 15:19–20)

...the heart is deceitful above all things and **desperately wicked**. (Jeremiah 17:9)

2. The pure heart is an undivided heart.

b. Purity of the heart

- It means the removal of **all** contaminants.
- It also means "unmixed" or "undiluted."

Then Jesus was approached by Pharisees and scribes from Jerusalem, who asked, ² "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they don't wash their hands when they eat. (Matt. 15:1–2)

3. The pure heart sees God in the ordinary.

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God."

•The pure in heart will see God in the life to come.

•The pure in heart will begin to see God in this life.



PSALM 18:25–26

²⁶ with the pure you prove yourself pure; but with the crooked you prove yourself shrewd.

²⁵ With the faithful you prove yourself faithful, with the blameless you prove yourself blameless,

How do we get this kind of heart?

•We ask him to cleanse our hearts.

if we confess our sins, he is faithful and just will forgive us our sins, and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

•We ask him to change our hearts.

I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone, and give them a heart of flesh. (Ezk. 11:19)
