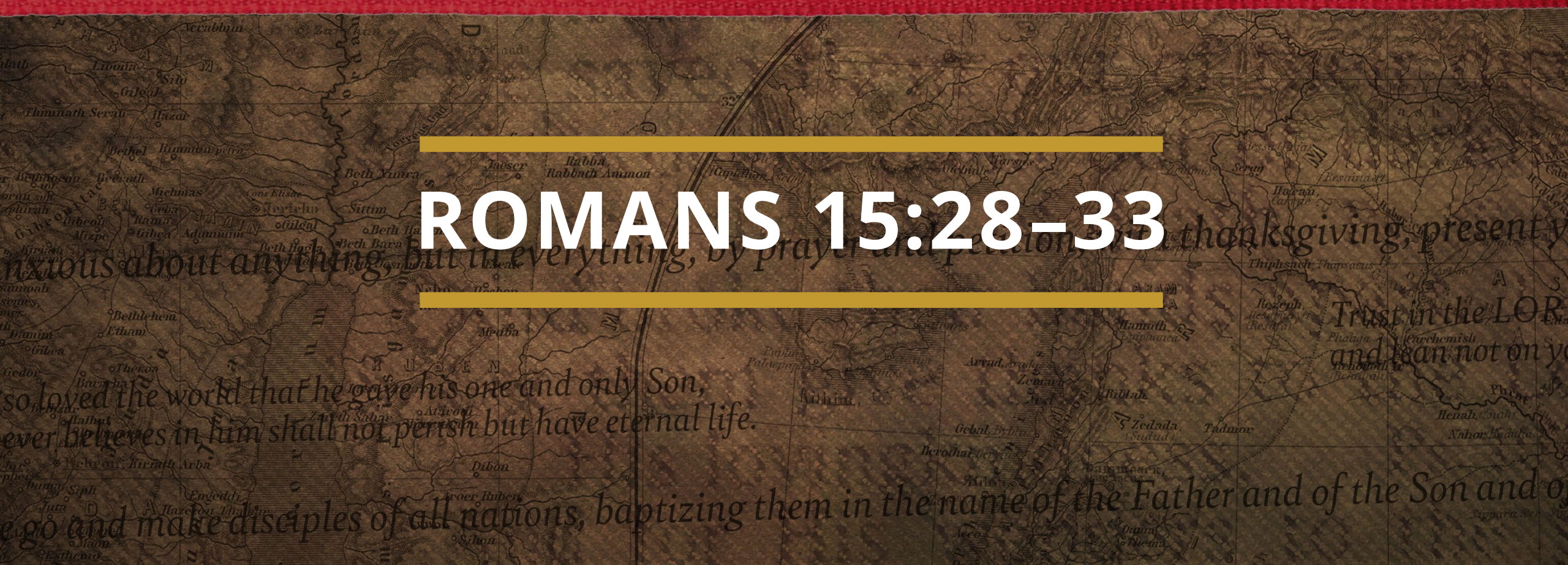




WHAT A NEW PASTOR EXPECTS OF HIS CHURCH
