Four Views Of The End Times

AMILLENNIALISM

No literal, open, visible, 1,000 year reign of Christ on earth.

POSTMILLENNIALISM

The ever-expanding progress of the gospel until the world becomes markedly Christian. Then, Christ returns.

HISTORICAL PREMILLENNIALISM

Christ will return physically and visibly to usher in the millennial reign.

DISPENSATIONALISM

The millennial reign of Christ will begin after his return, at the end of a distinct seven-year period know as the tribulation.
