Week 4: (10th May) Mother's Day Lesson- Mom you are special to me!

To encourage our children, the importance of celebrating our mother's for how special they are, and what they do for us, as well as to obey and honour them, as it is a command from the Lord, to all His children who belong to Him and love Him.



Week 5: (17th May) Abraham's Big Test- Remembering God's promises!

It can be difficult to trust that when someone makes a promise, that they will keep it. We can say with joy, that our God will always keep His promise, and be there to take care of us, because He wants the best for us! Abraham had to trust that God would not only remember the promises He made to him, but that when the time was right, there would be blessings to enjoy when he put his faith and trust in a good, good Father!

Week 6: (24th May) Abraham's Big Test- Having patience to wait on God's Promises!

We show faith and our trust in God, when we practice having to be patient to wait on Him. Being patient can be very tough and very hard, especially when you want something right now! By Abraham practising patience with God, he learned obedience, rest and joy, and that good things can come to those who wait patiently on Him.

**Week 7: (31st May) Abraham's Big Test- Obeying your leaders!**

By obeying our leaders, like our parents, guardians, teachers, and other people who lead us, we learn to put our faith and trust in God, to look and care for our needs as His children. God put our leaders in place so that we can be looked after, because this is how much He truly cares for us!

Week 8: (7th June) Dreams Come True- (Joseph's story)- What I say and do (Week 1 PDF)

Joseph obeyed God by asking for help to say and do good things, like forgiving his brothers, even though they had treated him very badly. It is important that like Joseph, we practice being a good example too, in what we say and do to others.
