All we are required to do is remain fixed on Jesus who has overcome the world and its difficulties, and who will give us the strength to have faith, hold onto our hope and learn that love can conquer our fears and anxieties.

Week 4: (10th May)- Mother's Day Lesson: Mom you are special to me!

To encourage our children, the importance of celebrating our mother's for how special they are, and what they do for us, as well as to obey and honour them, as it is a command from the Lord, to all His children who belong to Him and love Him.

Week 5: (17th May)- Keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus- Keeping the Faith

1 John 5:4 "...for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith."

Faith guides us to trust that God will help us overcome worries, anxieties and the things that we may fear in our daily lives. It is important that we learn to keep the faith in Jesus fixing our trust and dependence on Him, as He will give us the strength to endure and overcome; as He already has overcome in victory over our enemy the devil.

Week 6: (24th May)- Keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus- Holding onto Hope

Hebrews 10:23 "Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise."

No matter the things of earth and heaven, nothing can separate us from the love of God, and nothing can keep us from the plans and promises that God desires for us as His children. We have a hope that the God we trust in, is faithful to help us overcome our daily experiences if we keep our eyes fixed on Him.

God desires that we know this love, but not just keep it for ourselves, but that we would serve and love others around us, especially in times of crisis, or in our greatest difficulties and challenges.
