A HEART TO FORGIVE

26th March

A WALK OF FORGIVENESS: It can be quite hurtful, to be sold into slavery, and then thrown into prison for something you didn't do. However, despite the trouble that Joseph went through, he knew God had called him for a greater purpose; and to walk in this blessing meant that he had to forgive his brothers and the people that had given him trouble.
