JESUS REAL LIKE YOU AND ME: Would you ever believe that the Son of the Living God grew up as a normal child just like you and me? Like us, Jesus faced all the things that we as His children always struggle with, like fear, sadness, hurt, and pain; but also enjoyed learning all the things that bring us joy, like family, friends and love. The greatest thing that our Saviour Jesus Christ did was to learn how his brothers and sisters live in this broken world; and to show us the importance of trusting in a loving, Heavenly Father.

FOCUS: Did you know... A young Jesus was missing from his family for three days? The story of Jesus, real like you and me, shows us the humility of our heavenly Father; and the amazing plan He had for us by sending His son to live like us, so that we could be shown His heart and love for our well-being.

Pharisee, meeting with Jesus meant learning the things about God that showed him he no longer needed to be living in the ways of his old life like he did as a religious man; but that he now had the chance to live his life as a new creation in Christ.

FOCUS: Did you know... that Nicodemus had to meet Jesus at night because he was afraid of being seen by other leaders who did not like Jesus' teachings? Meeting with Jesus shows the importance of seeking and following God no matter the circumstances, and to know the only way to life is through the personal relationship we have with Jesus.

IFSUS IS BAPTISED: Imagine witnessing the amazing day, when Jesus took a step of obedience in fulfilling his ministry; by being baptised in the River Jordan by his cousin John the Baptist. What great celebrations heaven must have made to see this glorious day come, and to see the plans of a future Saviour become the hope and freedom for all who love and desire to know him.

FOCUS: Did you know... that God spoke down from heaven as soon as Jesus was baptised? The story of Jesus is Baptised shows us the powerful and humble way, that our Saviour Jesus Christ went before His heavenly Father in obedience through being baptised; in order to fulfil the plans of his ministry.







DESUS-THE LIVING WATER: Jesus tells us that when we are thirsty in wanting to know more about him and the Word of God, he is like living water that can satisfy our thirstiness. Just like water which we need for drinking, we also need to learn and know more about Jesus, as this is important in growing more like God, and being used for our heavenly Father's wonderful purposes.

FOCUS: Did you know... Jesus also called himself the bread of life? Jesus- the Living Water tells the story of when his thirsty children meet the love of a Saviour who satisfies all our needs when we come to know more of him.

DESUS COMES FOR DINNER: Picture this-you come to the town square, noticing that crowds of people are surrounding a man, who seems to be preaching to them. Since you cannot see, you begin climbing up a tree, then half way up; this same preacher asks your permission to come have dinner at your house. For Zacchaeus, the untimely invitation of Jesus begins an incredible journey of forgiveness, restoration and hope for a new way of life.

FOCUS: Did you know...Zacchaeus did not have many friends because of his dishonesty? Jesus comes for Dinner tells the incredible story of a man who sought after Jesus in an unlikely way, but found true hope and forgiveness because of his willingness to change.
