

EKKLESIA: THE CALLED OUT ONES

"I will build my Church" – Jesus (Matt 16)

Ekklesia: Greek = a gathering of citizens called out from their homes into some public place.

Ekklesia in Septuagint = assembly

Usage: Local and Universal

EKKLESIA: THE CALLED OUT ONES

Definition:

The church is a body of Believers in Jesus Christ summoned by God and called out by Him from among the Jews and Gentiles, who through Christ's death have been savingly reconciled to God and have received new life in the Spirit. It includes all such persons, whether in heaven or on earth. While universal in nature, it finds expression in local groupings of believers that display the same qualities as does the body of Christ as a whole.

Matt. 16:16-19

Peter: "You are the Christ (Messiah, the anointed one), the Son of the living God." And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven."

"I also say to you that you are Peter (Greek, Petros—a large piece of rock), and upon this rock (Greek, petra—a huge rock) I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it."

THE PURPOSE AND UNITY OF THE CHURCH

Matthew 22:36-40 (ESV)

"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

THE PURPOSE AND UNITY OF THE CHURCH

Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV)

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

1. WORSHIP

(Love the Lord you God with all your heart, soul and mind)

2. WORD

(Teaching them to observe all I have commanded them)

3. COMMUNITY

(Discipling, love your neighbour as yourself, ministry)

4. EVANGELISM AND MERCY

(Love your neighbour, go to all nations)
