Navigating Right Relationships - Week 2

We learned last week that to navigate Relationships successfully, against the things that are SEEN & UNSEEN, that have the potential to blow us off course, we need to have Constant Course Correction!

We don't just invite God into our relationships, we build our relationships around Him, and when we do, we get His blessings!

I want to show you 3 different ways where Abraham & Sarah LEARNED to honor God in their relationship.

I. Trust God even when the future is unclear
Genesis 12:1-2 NIV

Genesis 12:4 NIV

If you want a relationship blessed by God, it has to be a relationship led by God.

Here's a way to test your Obedience. If God is prompting you, leading you to do something, you don't need the FAITH to understand the whole plan, you just need to take the next step!

II. A God-centered love helps forgive and rebuild trust, even after the mistakes
I'm going to be sensitive and direct: When two people surrender to God, there's always HOPE.

III. A God-centered love hangs on, even when HOPE runs out.
Romans 4:18 NIV
