# Romans 8:26-27 [Legacy Standard Bible]

<sup>26</sup>And in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words; <sup>27</sup>and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

### I. The Condition

1 Peter 2:3

3if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord.

Psalm 34:8 (LSB)

<sup>8</sup>O taste and see that Yahweh is good; How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!

Psalm 34:18 (LSB)

<sup>18</sup>Yahweh is near to the brokenhearted And saves those who are crushed in spirit.

- Abiding of the Word of God in the children of God (John 15:7)
- Guidance from the Spirit (John 16:13)
- Sanctification of the believer (John 17:17)
- Perseverance and fruit (Mark 4)
- Gradually longs for meat (Hebrews 5:14)
- Production of Christlike love (1 Corinthians 13)

# John Piper: A Hunger for God

"If you don't feel strong desires for the manifestation of the glory of God, it is not because you have drunk deeply and are satisfied. It is because you have nibbled so long at the table of the world. Your soul is stuffed with small things, and there is no room for the great."

- <sup>11</sup>Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul,
- <sup>12</sup>by keeping your conduct excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good works, as they observe them, glorify God in the day of visitation.
