

- 49,697


Events, Accomplishments, Problems:

- Temple begun; sacrifices made
- Feast of Tabernacles celebrated
- Samaritans make trouble and work ceased until 520
- Temple complete in 516.

Themes:

Haggai □ A call to complete the reconstruction Zechariah □ The future restoration through Messiah



"Now Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the prophet, a descendant of Iddo, prophesied to the Jews in Judah and Jerusalem in the name of the God of Israel, who was over them." (Ezra 5:1)

"Yet many of the priests and Levites and heads of fathers' households, the old men who had seen the first temple, wept with a loud voice when the foundation of this house laid before their eyes, while many shouted aloud for joy." (Ezra 3:12)

- Wall rebuilt in 52 days despite opposition from Sanballat, Tobiah, and Gesem
- Walls dedicated and Law read.




