Matthew 12:38-42 [Legacy Standard Bible]

- ³⁸Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered and said to Him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You."
- ³⁹But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation eagerly seeks for a sign; and yet no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet;

Sign: clearly a <u>supernatural work</u> of God

Matthew 12:9–13 (LSB)

- ⁹And departing from there, He went into their synagogue.
- ¹⁰And behold, <u>a man was there whose hand was withered.</u> And they questioned Jesus, saying, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?"—so that they might accuse Him.
- ¹¹And He said to them, "What man is there among you who has a sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not take hold of it and lift it out?
- ¹²"How much more valuable then is a man than a sheep! So then, it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath."
- ¹³Then He said to the man, <u>"Stretch out your hand!" He stretched it out,</u> and it was restored to normal, like the other.

- ²⁸for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'
- ²⁹"But Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.'

²²And while they were gathering together in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men;

²³and they will kill Him, and He will be raised on the third day." And they were deeply grieved.

Matthew 20:19 (LSB)

¹⁹and will deliver Him over to the Gentiles to mock and flog and crucify Him, and on the third day He will be raised up."

Sign of Jonah: Life, Death, Burial, and Supernatural Resurrection

Acts 2:23-24 (LSB)

²³this Man, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of lawless men and put Him to death.

²⁴"But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

Revelation 1:17–18 (LSB)

¹⁷And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "Do not fear; I am the first and the last,

¹⁸and the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forever and ever, and I have the keys of death and of Hades.

n. "Apparent Death Theory" or "Swoon Theory" (18th century)

Matthew 28:12-15 (LSB)

¹²And when they had assembled with the elders and took counsel together, they gave a <u>large sum of money to the soldiers</u>, ¹³and said, "You are to say, 'His disciples came by night and stole

Him away while we were asleep.'

¹⁴"And if this is heard before the governor, we will win him over and keep you out of trouble."

¹⁵And they took the money and did as they had been instructed; and this story was widely spread among the Jews, and is to this day.

⁶Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life.

³⁰"Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now commanding men <u>that everyone everywhere should repent</u>, ³¹because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He determined, having furnished proof to all by raising Him from the dead."

Acts 26:20 (LSB)

²⁰but kept declaring both to those of Damascus first, and also at Jerusalem and then throughout all the region of Judea, and even to the Gentiles, that they should <u>repent and turn to God, practicing deeds appropriate to repentance.</u>
