1. Yahweh's Omnipotence

Jonah 1:9 (LSB)

⁹And he said to them, "I am a Hebrew, and I fear Yahweh, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry land."

- Yahweh hurled... a great wind (1:4)
- Yahweh appointed... a great fish (1:17)
- Yahweh answered... Yahweh listened... Yahweh cast (Jonah 2)
- Yahweh commanded... the fish (2:10)
- Yahweh relented... the evil (3:10)
- Yahweh appointed... a plant (4:6)
- Yahweh appointed... a worm (4:7)
- Yahweh appointed... scorching east wind (4:8)

2. Yahweh's Omnipresence

Jonah 1:3 (LSB)

³Yet Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish <u>from the presence of Yahweh</u>. So he went down to Joppa, found a ship which was going to Tarshish, and paid its fare and went down into it to go with them to Tarshish <u>from the presence of Yahweh</u>. [Psalm 139:7-8]

- Yahweh is present at Joppa, on the ship, and in the sea (Jonah 1)
- Yahweh is present in the belly of the fish at the depths (Jonah 2)
- Yahweh is present in Nineveh (Jonah 3)
- Yahweh is present intimately in the life of all people (Jonah 4)

Jonah 1:2 (LSB)

²"Arise, go to Nineveh, the great city, and call out against it, for their evil has come up before Me."

⁴Then Jonah began to go into the city, one day's walk; and he called out and said, "Yet forty days and Nineveh will be overthrown."

2 Kings 14:25 [Legacy Standard Bible]



Nahum 3:1 (LSB)

¹Woe to the city of bloodshed, completely full of deception and pillage; Her prey never departs.

Nahum 3:3 (LSB)

³Horsemen charging, And swords flaming, and spears flashing, Many slain, a mass of corpses, And there is no end to dead bodies— They stumble over the dead bodies!

- ¹²saying, 'These last men have worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us who have borne the burden of the day and the scorching heat.'
