## KING JESUS - PART 8

QUESTION 1 Get-to-know-me

What are some of your biggest pet peeves?

When people get angry they typically choose silence or violence (aka they withdraw or get really loud). What is your normal response in heated moments?

QUESTION 2 Into-the-Bible

## Read Matthew 21:12-17, Mark 11:15-19, Luke 19:45-48, John 2:13-16

Compare and contrast these stories of Jesus cleansing the temple. What stands out to you?

John uses the phrase "Zeal for you house will consume me"... does Zeal always equate to anger?

## Read Ephesians 4:26-27

What do you think Paul is communicating about anger in this passage? Does this passage justify being angry or is it a warning to get rid of your anger as quickly as possible?

QUESTION 3 Take-it-home

Pastor Michael shared that, "Whatever it is that you believe anger and outrage are helping you accomplish, love will do a better job."

In what ways have you seen Christians use anger as their primary motivation? In what ways have you used anger as your motivation? What would it look like to use love as your motivation instead in those circumstances?
