RETHINKING HELL - PART 2

QUESTION 1 Get-to-know-me

In the sermon, Pastor Nathan challenged the idea of hell being God's punishment and proposed hell was God's protection. Does this challenge the way you traditionally thought about hell? How does this idea change the gospel message?

QUESTION 2 Into-the-Bible

Read Mark 7:21, Romans 7:14-19, Jeremiah 17:9, Galatians 5:17
