QUESTION 1

BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT:

1. Invite - ask Jesus to baptize you in the Holy Spirit

God is not going to do anything you don't want Him to do. He is a gentleman. He responds to our invitation.

2. Praise - open your mouth and express your adoration to God

Worship God with the language He has already blessed you with. Begin with the lyrics on the screen, and as you begin to settle into God's presence, begin to use your own words. Your own words are more personal and authentic than someone else's words.

3. Surrender - yield to any deep welling up within your spirit and allow that inner surge to break through in an unknown language

It's not about striving in your own strength, it's about yielding to the Holy Spirit within you. As you do, there will come a moment when you will feel the Spirit well up within you and want to break forth in spontaneous, inspired speech.

4. Faith - speak out those words that God places on your heart

Everything we receive from God is by faith. In faith, yield to the Spirit's power and speak out that inspired speech.

God won't open your mouth

It doesn't happen involuntarily. There won't be a magical moment where God comes and moves your tongue for you. It requires your full participation. We have to step out in faith and partner with God.

· The enemy will cast doubt

He will cast doubt. He will cast fear. He will try and make you believe you weren't meant to experience this. Don't buy the lie. Know that as you seek God, He wants to baptize you. Don't worry when, just surrender yourself fully to Him.
