QUESTION 1 Get-to-know-me

What do you know about the ancient gods of Mesopotamia, Greece, Rome, Egypt, etc.? What were the dominant character traits they were known for?

Pastor Michael talked about how we often create God in our own image. In his sermon he provided 4 questions to reflect on: Does God agree with you on everything? Does God hate all the people you hate? Does God vote for the person you voted for? & is God passionate about that things you're passionate about?

Do you find yourself answering yes to any of those questions? What can we do to push against the human desire to make God in our own image?

OUESTION 2 Into-the-Bible

Read Isaiah 49:15-16, Luke 15:11-32

While God's people were in exile, God assured his people of his compassion. What comes to mind when you consider God's compassion for his people being related to a mother's care for her infant?

What does the parable of the lost son teach us about God's compassion & grace?

OUESTION 3 Take-it-home

Pastor Michael shared how, "we become like what we worship" and how we're meant to reflect God's character traits of compassion & grace. Who is someone in your life you need to start (or do a better job of) feeling compassion & acting graciously towards?
