OUESTION 1 Get-to-know-me

Before listening to this series...

How would you have defined poverty? How would you have described God's mission for the world?

OUESTION 2 Into-the-Bible

Read Colossians 1:15-20, Ephesians 1:9-10

What does it mean to "come under the authority of Christ"? How can we play an active role in building God's kingdom?

OUESTION 3 Take-it-home

Pastor Nate shared how poverty isn't about a lack of material things. Instead, poverty is rooted in the brokenness of 4 foundational relationships (God, Self, Others, Creation). He shared how Sin causes a...

Poverty of SPIRITUAL INTIMACY — where we deny God's existence & authority and see everything as material OR we worship false gods & spirits

Poverty of BEING — where we develop a God-complex and see ourselves as God OR we live with shame and struggle with low self-esteem

Poverty of COMMUNITY — where we become self-centered and exploit and abuse others

Poverty of STEWARDSHIP — where we lose our sense of purpose in stewarding creation and either become lazy or workaholics
