- Look up unknown words in dictionary- write out the definition
- Look up cross-references
- Reference maps and places mentioned

Interpretation- Who, What, When, Where, Why?

-Paraphrase the verses (summarize in your own words)

Application – How Should It Change Me?

- 1) What does this passage teach me about God (His attributes and character)?

- 3) How should I respond?
